## Madam Speaker:

The Education Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 23**, SUICIDE PREVENTION REVISIONS, by Representative S. Eliason, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 14 through 17:
  - 14 This bill:
  - under certain circumstances, allows a school employee {-or-} agent or school resource officer to intervene and ask
  - a student questions regarding the student's suicidal thoughts, **physically** self-harming behavior,
  - or thoughts of harming others, for the purposes of:
- 2. *Page 4, Lines 103 through 111:* 
  - 103 (7) (a) If a school employee { or } agent or school resource officer believes a student is at-risk of attempting suicide,
  - 104 <u>physical</u> self-harming, or harming others, the school employee { or } agent , or school resource officer may intervene and ask a student
  - 105 <u>questions regarding the student's suicidal thoughts</u>, <u>physically</u> <u>self-harming behavior</u>, <u>or thoughts of</u>
  - 106 harming others for the purposes of:
  - (i) referring the student to appropriate prevention services; and
  - (ii) informing the student's parent or legal guardian.
  - (b) On or before September 1, 2014, a school district or charter school shall develop

- 110 <u>and adopt a policy regarding</u> { <u>school employee</u> } <u>intervention measures consistent</u> <u>with</u>
- 111 <u>Subsection (7)(a)</u> <u>while requiring the minimum degree of intervention to accomplish</u> <u>the goals of this section</u> .
