Madam Speaker:

The Education Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 215**, PUBLIC SCHOOL EMPLOYEE BACKGROUND CHECKS, by Representative S. Handy, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Line 15:*

- 15 school since the date of the initial background check; ~~{and}~~
- ▶ requires the Criminal Investigations and Technical Services Division of the Department of Public Safety to notify an administrator at a school district, charter school, or private school when a new entry is made against an employee or volunteer whose fingerprints are held on file regarding any matters involving an alleged offense against property; and

2. *Page 3, Lines 72 through 77:*

- 72 (C) any matters involving an alleged alcohol-related offense; ~~{or}~~
- 73 (D) any matters involving an alleged offense against the person under Title 76,
Chapter
- 74 5, Offenses Against the Person ~~{or}~~ ; or
- (E) any matters involving an alleged offense against property under Title 76,
Chapter 6, Offenses Against Property.
- 75 (iii) The [cost of maintaining the separate file shall be paid by the] school district,
76 charter school, or private school shall pay the cost of maintaining the separate file
~~{from fees~~
- 77 charged to [those] applicants, volunteers, and employees submitting fingerprints} .
