NOTICE OF BILL RETURNED TO THE RULES COMMITTEE

March 7, 2014

Mr. President:

With committee review, the Education Committee has returned **H.B. 236**, STATE SCHOOL BOARD NOMINATION REVISIONS, by Representative K. Powell, to the Rules Committee without a recommendation and with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 2, Line 37 through Page 3, Line 60:
 - 37 {<u>(5) (a) "Lobbyist" means an individual who contracts for economic</u> consideration, other
 - 38 <u>than reimbursement for reasonable travel expenses, with a principal to lobby a public official.</u>
 - 39 <u>(b) "Lobbyist" does not include:</u>
 - 40 <u>(i) a government officer;</u>
 - 41 (ii) a member or employee of the legislative branch of state government;
 - 42 <u>(iii) a person while appearing at or providing written comments to a hearing conducted</u>
 - 43 <u>in accordance with Title 63G, Chapter 3, Utah Administrative Rulemaking Act, or Title 63G,</u>
 - 44 Chapter 4, Administrative Procedures Act;
 - 45 <u>(iv) a person participating on or appearing before an advisory or study task</u> force.
 - 46 <u>commission, board, or committee constituted by the Legislature or any agency or</u> <u>department of</u>
 - 47 state government, except legislative standing, appropriation, or interim committees;
 - 48 (v) a representative of a political party;
 - 49 <u>(vi) an individual representing a bona fide church solely for the purpose of protecting</u>







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- 50 <u>the right to practice the religious doctrines of the church, unless the individual or church makes</u>
- 51 <u>an expenditure that confers a benefit on a public official;</u>
- 52 <u>(vii) a newspaper, television station or network, radio station or network, periodical of</u>
- 53 general circulation, or book publisher for the purpose of publishing news items, editorials,
- 54 other comments, or paid advertisements that directly or indirectly urge legislative or executive
- 55 action; or
- 56 (viii) an individual who appears on the individual's own behalf before a committee of
- 57 <u>the Legislature or an agency of the executive branch of state government solely for the purpose</u>
- 58 of testifying in support of or in opposition to legislative or executive action.
- 59 (6) "Principal" is as defined in Section 36-11-102.
