Madam Speaker:

The Government Operations Committee recommends **H.B. 283**, NONPROFIT ENTITY RECEIPT OF GOVERNMENT MONEY, by Representative R. Menlove, be replaced and reports a favorable recommendation on **1st Sub. H.B. 283**, NONPROFIT ENTITY RECEIPT OF GOVERNMENT MONEY with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 16 through 18:
 - imposing requirements on a nonprofit entity's receipt of state
 - 17 { requiring reporting to the Utah Public Finance website; and }
 - authorizing a state entity to seek return of state money if the nonprofit entity
- 2. *Page 2, Line 34:*
 - 34 {-63J-9-203, Utah Code Annotated 1953-}
- 3. Page 6, Lines 165 through 170:
 - 165 { Section 6. Section 63J-9-202 is enacted to read:
 - 166 <u>63J-9-202.</u> Utah Public Finance Website reporting.
 - 167 <u>In accordance with 63A-3-402, a state entity shall report on the Utah Public</u>
 <u>Finance</u>
 - 168 Website the state money provided to a nonprofit entity in accordance with this part.
 - 169 Section {7} <u>6</u> . Section {63J-9-203} <u>63J-9-202</u> is enacted to read: 170 {63J-9-203.} <u>63J-9-202</u> Nonprofit entity's return of state money.







- 4. Page 5, Line 147 through Page 6, Line 164:
 - 147 Subsection (3)(b)
 - 148 (4) before the state money is released to the nonprofit entity, the nonprofit entity
 - 149 <u>submits to the state entity:</u>
 - (a) a form signed by the board members that certifies that the board members:
 - 151 (i) have read and understand the nonprofit entity's bylaws; and
 - 152 <u>(ii) have had explained to them the benefit of insurance covering the activities of</u>
 the
 - 153 board; and
 - 154 (b) (i) a form signed by the chief executive officer, executive director, or board
 - president that certifies that the board understands basic board responsibilities, including:
 - 156 (A) determining the mission of the nonprofit entity;
 - 157 <u>(B) hiring and, if needed, dismissing the chief executive officer or executive director;</u>
 - 158 <u>(C) planning and evaluating;</u>
 - 159 (D) recruiting and orienting new board members;
 - 160 <u>(E) assessing board performance;</u>
 - 161 (F) providing financial oversight;
 - 162 <u>(G) ensuring integrity and accountability; or</u>
 - 163 (H) ensuring adequate resources; or
 - 164 <u>(ii) a standard of ethics document adopted by the nonprofit entity</u>} .
