The Natural Resources, Agriculture, and Environment Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 370**, CANAL SAFETY AMENDMENTS, by Representative Johnny Anderson, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 2, Lines 39 through 48:*

- 39        (2) The state engineer shall, by July 1, 2017, inventory and maintain a list of all open,  
40        human-made water conveyance systems in the state, including the following information  
      on  
41        each conveyance system:  
42        (a) {location} alignment ;  
43        (b) contact information of the owner;  
44        (c) maximum flow capacity in cubic feet per second;  
45        (d) whether the conveyance system is used for flood or storm  
      water management; and  
46        (e) {the} notice of the adoption of a management plan for the conveyance  
      system {, once it has been adopted,} as  
47        reported to the Division of Water Resources under Section 73-10-33.  
      = (3) The owner of an open, human-made water conveyance system shall inform  
      the state engineer if the information described in Subsection (2) changes.
