Mr. President:

The Government Operations and Political Subdivisions Committee reports a favorable recommendation on S.B. 51, LOCAL GOVERNMENT ENTITIES AMENDMENTS, by Senator J. Stevenson, with the following amendments:

1. Page 27, Line 828 through Page 28, Line 850:

828 (g) accept a grant, contribution, or loan, directly through the sale of securities or 829 equipment trust certificates or otherwise, from the United States, or from a department, 830 instrumentality, or agency of the United States { , to: } 831 { (i) sell or lease property; 832 (ii) assist in or operate transit-oriented or transit-supportive developments; 833 [(i)] (iii) establish, finance, participate as a limited partner or member in a development 834 with limited liabilities in accordance with Subsection (1)(I), construct, improve, maintain, or 835 operate transit facilities, equipment, and transit-oriented developments or transit-supportive 836 developments; or 837 [(ii)] (iv) (h) study and plan transit facilities in accordance with any legislation passed by 838 Congress; 839 {-(h)-} cooperate with and enter into an agreement with the state or an <u>(i)</u>
