Mr. President:

The Business and Labor Committee recommends **S.B. 137**, HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONAL TRUTH IN ADVERTISING, by Senator T. Weiler, be replaced and favorably recommends **1st Sub. S.B. 137**, HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONAL TRUTH IN ADVERTISING with the following amendments:

1. *Page 3, Lines 64 through 65:*

- 64 (g) "Patient encounter" means an interaction in a health care facility, health care  
clinic or office, or other location as defined by the division by rule, in which a patient  
can see a health care  
65 provider delivering services directly to a patient.

1. *Page 3, Lines 68 through 72:*

- 68 (3) A health care provider's identification may be covered if required under  
sterilization  
69 or isolation protocols.  
70 (4) A health care provider is not required to wear identification:  
71 (a) if wearing identification would jeopardize the health care provider's safety;

72 (b) (i) in an office in which:
