Mr. President:

The Business and Labor Committee recommends S.B. 137, HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONAL TRUTH IN ADVERTISING, by Senator T. Weiler, be replaced and favorably recommends 1st Sub. S.B. 137, HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONAL TRUTH IN ADVERTISING with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 3, Lines 64 through 65:
 - 64 (g) "Patient encounter" means an interaction in a health care facility, health care clinic or office, or other location as defined by the division by rule, in can see a health care
 - provider delivering services directly to a patient.
- 1. *Page 3, Lines 68 through 72:*
 - 68 (3) A health care provider's identification may be covered if required under sterilization
 - 69 <u>or isolation protocols.</u>
 - 70 (4) A health care provider is not required to wear identification:
 - 71 (a) if wearing identification would jeopardize the health care provider's safety;

{and} or

72 (b) (i) in an office in which:

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- 2. *Page 3, Lines 78 through 83:*
 - 78 (A) of a solo health care provider; or
 - 79 (B) of a single type of health care provider {; or }
 - 80 {<u>(C) with no more than two types of health care providers in which each</u> patient is seen
 - 81 <u>by only one health care provider in the office, a patient does not receive services from another</u>
 - 82 <u>health care provider in the office, and the health care providers do not provide cross</u> <u>coverage</u>
 - 83 of services for the patients of other health care providers in the office.
