H.B. 76 Insurance Related Revisions (*Rep. J. Bird*)

H.B. 203 Bail Bond Recovery Licensure Board Amendments (*Rep. E. Redd*)

Rep. Redd explained the bill to the committee assisted by Jason Chapman of the Bureau of Criminal Identification.

MOTION: Rep. Duckworth moved to pass H.B. 203 out favorably. The motion passed unanimously with Rep. Anderson and Rep. Wilson absent for the vote.

S.B. 27 Reauthorization of Massage Therapy Licensure Act (*Sen. J. Valentine*)

MOTION: Rep. Peterson moved to pass SB 27 out favorably. The motion passed with Rep. Roberts voting in opposition.
