Chair Ray called the meeting to order at 7:40 a.m.

**MOTION:** Rep. Chavez-Houck moved to approve the minutes of the February 24, 2014, meeting.  
The motion passed unanimously with Rep. Barlow absent for the vote.

**S.C.R. 5 Concurrent Resolution Supporting the Master Plan (Sen. M. Dayton)**

Sen. Dayton explained the resolution to the committee.

Spoke to the bill: Mr. Palmer De Paulis, speaking as a citizen

**MOTION:** Rep. Chavez-Houck moved to pass the resolution out favorably. The motion passed unanimously with Rep. Barlow absent for the vote.

**H.B. 384 Concussion and Head Injury Amendments (Rep. P. Ray)**

Chair Ray explained the bill to the committee.

**MOTION:** Rep. Cosgrove moved to pass the bill out favorably. The motion passed unanimously with Rep. Barlow absent for the vote.

**MOTION:** Rep. Cosgrove moved to place H.B. 384 on the Consent Calendar. The motion

passed unanimously with Rep. Barlow absent for the vote.

**H.B. 146 Child Care Amendments (Rep. R. Menlove)**

Rep. Menlove explained the bill to the committee with the assistance of Dr. Marc Babitz, Utah Department of Health.

**MOTION:** Rep. Menlove moved to replace H.B. 146 with 2nd Substitute H.B. 146. The motion passed unanimously.

**H.B. 348 Child Support Amendments (Rep. K. Stratton)**

Rep. Stratton explained the bill to the committee.

**MOTION:** Rep. Barlow moved to replace H.B. 348 with 1st Substitute H.B. 348. The motion passed unanimously with Rep. Menlove absent for the vote.

**MOTION:** Rep. Barlow moved to amend the bill as follows:

*1. Page 4, Lines 88 through 91:*

88 (8) If Subsection (7)(d)(v)(A) or (B) is met and a ~~{stay-at-home}~~ parent  
89 ~~{applies for}~~ receives  
90 assistance under Title 35A, Chapter 3, Employment Support Program, or the child  
91 becomes subject to the care and custody of the state, income may be  
92 ~~{automatically}~~ imputed at the federal minimum wage for a 40-hour work week to  
93 ~~{that}~~ either parent. A  
94 payor parent's alimony obligation may not be reduced by ~~{the}~~ this imputation.

The motion passed unanimously.
