 - 11 Highlighted Provisions:
 - This bill:
 - provides that a district court shall consider, when determining child custody in a
 - separation or divorce, whether the parent has <u>intentionally</u> exposed the child to pornography or
 - 15 material harmful to a child; and
 - provides that a juvenile court shall consider, when determining whether to terminate
 - 17 a parent's rights, whether the parent has <u>intentionally</u> exposed the child to pornography or
 - 18 material harmful to a minor.
- 2. Page 2, Lines 43 through 46:
 - and nature of the relationship between a parent and child; [and]
 - 44 (iv) whether the parent has intentionally exposed the child to pornography or material harmful to a
