8	General Description:
9	This bill modifies the Motor Vehicle Act by amending provisions relating to vehicle
10	impoundment.
11	Highlighted Provisions:
12	This bill:
13	 provides that the Motor Vehicle Division or any peace officer, without a warrant,
14	may seize and take possession of any vehicle, vessel, or outboard motor:
15	• whose operator is operating the vehicle and has never been issued a valid driver
16	license; or
17	• whose operator is operating the vehicle with a suspended or revoked driver
18	license or with a driver license that has been expired for more than one year; $\hat{H} \rightarrow [and]$
18a	authorizes a peace officer to release a vehicle that is subject to impoundment to another
18b	<u>licensed driver in certain circumstances; and</u> 🗲Ĥ
