36	[(1)] (2) The Utah National Guard may provide tuition and fees assistance to [members	
37	for study at postsecondary institutions of learning, including Applied Technology Centers] a	
38	member of the Utah National Guard for study at an institution of higher education, subject to	
39	the following requirements:	
40	(a) the individual must be, at the time [he or she] the individual receives the assistance,	
41	an active member of the Utah National Guard[:]; and	
42	(b) the assistance is for tuition <u>and fees</u> only and [shall be not] <u>may not be</u> more than

44	individual.	
45	[(2)] (3) (a) Tuition and fees assistance shall be awarded for each academic year.

47	(b) An individual may apply to the adjutant general of the state for assistance for each	
48	year during which [he or she] the individual is an active member of the Utah National Guard.	
49	(c) In awarding assistance, the adjutant general shall consider the recruitment and	
50	retention needs of the <u>Utah</u> National Guard.
