12 This bill reauthorizes the Rural Residency Training Program.

27 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*



28 Section 1. Section **53B-24-402** is amended to read:

29 **53B-24-402. Rural residency training program.**

30 (1) For purposes of this section:

31 (a) "Physician" means:

32 (i) a person licensed to practice medicine under Title 58, Chapter 67, Utah Medical
33 Practice Act or Title 58, Chapter 68, Utah Osteopathic Medical Practice Act; and

34 (ii) a person licensed to practice dentistry under Title 58, Chapter 69, Dentist and
35 Dental Hygienist Practice Act.

36 (b) "Rural residency training program" means an accredited clinical training program
37 as defined in Section **53B-24-102** which places a physician into a rural county for a part or all
38 of the physician's clinical training.

39 (2) (a) Subject to appropriations from the Legislature, the council shall establish a pilot
40 program to place physicians into rural residency training programs.

41 (b) The [~~pilot~~] program shall [~~begin July 1, 2005 and~~] sunset [~~July 1, 2015,~~] in
42 accordance with Section [~~63I-1-263~~] 63I-1-253.
