27	Section 1. Section 58-83-306 is amended to read:
28	58-83-306. Drugs approved for online prescribing, dispensing, and facilitation
29	Delivery of prescription drugs.

30	(1) An online prescriber may only prescribe, an online contract pharmacy may only
31	dispense, and an Internet facilitator may only facilitate the prescribing and dispensing of,
32	non-controlled, legend drugs [that have been]:
33	(a) <u>that have been</u> approved by the Food and Drug Administration;
34	(b) <u>that are prescribed to treat the condition for which the drug was approved[; and]</u> .
35	within the drug manufacturer's guidelines;
36	(c) <u>that are</u> specifically approved by the division for online prescribing by
37	administrative rule adopted in accordance with Title 63G, Chapter 3, Utah Administrative
38	Rulemaking Act[-];
39	(d) that are prescribed for a person who is:
40	(i) 18 years of age or older; or
41	(ii) at least 16 years of age:
42	(A) if permitted by the state or country in which the patient will receive the drug;
43	(B) with parental consent, if required by the state or country in which the patient will
44	receive the drug; and
45	(C) only if the prescription is for a hormonal based contraceptive; and
46	(e) to a person who is located in another country, if the country is designated by the
47	division, by administrative rule, as a country with a regulatory framework for prescribing and
48	dispensing of drugs.
49	(2) If, after January 1, 2010, the Food and Drug Administration issues a clinical black
50	box warning with respect to any drug approved by the board under Subsection (1), the division
51	shall determine what action, if any, is necessary to protect the public health or welfare as a
52	result of the black box warning.

63	(a) an audit of the website; or
64	(b) records of the online prescriber, the Internet facilitator, or the online contract
65	pharmacy;
66	(4) using an online prescriber, online contract pharmacy, or Internet facilitator without
67	approval of the division;
68	(5) failing to inform a patient of the patient's freedom of choice in selecting who will
69	dispense a prescription in accordance with Subsection 58-83-305(1)(n);
70	(6) failing to keep the division informed of the name and contact information of the
71	Internet facilitator or online contract pharmacy; and
72	(7) violating the dispensing and labeling requirements of Chapter 17b, Part 8,
73	Dispensing Medical Practitioner and Dispensing Medical Practitioner Clinic Pharmacy.
