This bill amends provisions of the Mental Health Professional Practice Act.

 provides that an individual may represent oneself as a, or use the title of, social
worker if the individual possesses certified transcripts from an accredited institution
of higher education as described in the bill; and
▶ amends the qualifications for licensure as a clinical social worker, certified social
worker, and social service worker by adding completion of an education accredited
by the Canadian Association of Schools of Social Work.
