This bill increases the number of juvenile judges in the Fourth Juvenile District.

- increases the number of juvenile judges from four to five in the Fourth Juvenile District.

AMENDS:

78A-1-104, as last amended by Laws of Utah 2013, Chapter 68

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section 78A-1-104 is amended to read:

78A-1-104. Number of juvenile judges and jurisdictions.

The number of juvenile court judges shall be:

- (1) two juvenile judges in the First Juvenile District;
- (2) six juvenile judges in the Second Juvenile District;



- 28 (3) 10 juvenile judges in the Third Juvenile District;
- 29 (4) [~~four~~] five juvenile judges in the Fourth Juvenile District;
- 30 (5) three juvenile judges in the Fifth Juvenile District;
- 31 (6) one juvenile judge in the Sixth Juvenile District;
- 32 (7) two juvenile judges in the Seventh Juvenile District; and
- 33 (8) two juvenile judges in the Eighth Juvenile District.
