##### General Description:

This bill enacts provisions regarding freight train crew size requirements.

##### Highlighted Provisions:

This bill:

- ▶ provides definitions;
- ▶ prohibits a railroad from operating a freight train or light engine used in connection with the movement of freight unless it has a crew consisting of at least two individuals; and
- ▶ ~~{specifies the certification requirements for crew members operating a freight train or light engine used in connection with the movement of freight}~~ exempts a transit facility or a transit vehicle of a public transit district from the two individual crew requirement.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

Section 1. Section **56-1-25.5** is enacted to read:

#### **56-1-25.5. Freight train crew size.**

(1) As used in this section:

(a) "Public transit district" means a public transit district organized under Title 17B,

Chapter 2a, Part 8, Public Transit District Act.

(b) "~~railroad~~Railroad" means the same as that term is defined in 49 U.S.C. Sec.

20102.

(2) A railroad may not operate a freight train or light engine used in connection with the movement of freight unless the railroad has a crew consisting of at least ~~the following~~ ~~two individuals~~;

~~(a) a person who is certified as a locomotive engineer pursuant to 49 U.S.C. Sec. 20135; and~~

~~(b) a person who is certified as a conductor pursuant to 49 U.S.C. Sec. 20136.~~
