The Government Operations and Political Subdivisions Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 280**, UTAH NATIONAL GUARD COMMAND STRUCTURE AMENDMENTS, by Representative V. - 1. Page 3, Lines 68 through 71:
 - 68 (b) The chief of staff for air shall be <u>at least</u> a field grade federally recognized
 - 69 commissioned officer of the Utah National Guard with not less than five years of military
 - 70 service in the armed forces of a state or of the United States, at least three of which shall have
 - 71 been commissioned in the {<u>Air</u>} <u>Utah</u> National Guard {of the United States}. The officer shall:
