Chair McIff called the meeting to order at 4:20 p.m.

MOTION: Rep. Ward moved to approve the minutes of February 23, 2015. The motion passed unanimously with Rep. Thurston absent for the vote.

S.B. 103 Child Welfare Amendments (*Sen. W. Harper*)

Rep. Ray explained S.B. 103 to the committee.

MOTION: Rep. Barlow moved to pass H.B. 103 out favorably. The motion passed unanimously with Rep. Thurston absent for the vote.

MOTION: Rep. Ray moved to place S.B. 103 on the Consent Calendar. The motion failed for lack of a unanimous vote with Chair McIff and Rep. Redd voting in opposition and Rep. Thurston absent for the vote.

S.B. 149 Repeal of Funds (*Sen. A. Christensen*)

Rep. Fawson explained S.B. 149 to the committee.

MOTION: Rep. Ward moved to pass S.B. 149 out favorably. The motion passed unanimously with Rep. Thurston absent for the vote.

MOTION: Rep. Spendlove moved to place S.B. 149 on the Consent Calendar. The motion passed unanimously with Rep. Thurston absent for the vote.

S.B. 172 Emergency Medical Services Amendments (*Sen. C. Bramble*)

Sen. Bramble explained S. B. 172 to the committee.

MOTION: Rep. Barlow moved to pass S.B. 172 out favorably. The motion passed unanimously with Rep. Thurston absent for the vote.

H.B. 249 Rights of Children Conceived Through Artificial Insemination (*Rep. D. Pitcher*)

Rep. Pitcher explained 1st Substitute H.B. 249 to the committee.

MOTION: Rep. Ward moved to replace H.B. 249 with 1st Substitute H.B. 249, "Rights of Children Conceived Through Artificial Insemination." The motion passed unanimously with Rep. Thurston absent for the vote.

MOTION: Rep. Kennedy moved to pass 1st Substitute H.B. 249 out favorably. The motion passed unanimously.

MOTION: Rep. Spendlove moved adjourn the meeting. The motion passed unanimously.
