

# H.B. 84

## LEAD RECYCLING AMENDMENTS

Representative **Merrill F. Nelson** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Line 13:*

13 and recyclers as a suspect regulated metal; ~~{and}~~

2. *Page 1, Line 15:*

15 transactions with recyclers and metal dealers : and  
▶ exempts from the definition of a dealer specified types of businesses that accept lead batteries for recycling .

3. *Page 2, Lines 30 through 34:*

30 (2) "Dealer" means:

31 (a) a scrap metal processor or secondary metals dealer or recycler, but does not include :

(i)

32 junk dealers as defined in Section 76-6-1402 ~~{, or}~~ :

(ii) solid waste management facilities as defined

33 in Section 19-6-502; or

(iii) the following businesses that are authorized to accept delivery of used lead batteries for recycling under Sections 19-6-603, 19-6-604, and 19-6-605:

(A) retailers;

(B) wholesalers;

(C) battery manufacturers; and

(D) secondary lead smelters.

34 (b) a metals refiner.
