Senator Margaret Dayton proposes the following amendments:

- 1. Page 3, Lines 65 through 78:
 - (g) starts a campfire or camps on the bed of a navigable lake or river except in a posted and designated area;
 - 65 {-(g)} _(h) camps on [the beds of navigable lakes or rivers] state lands, except in posted [and]
 66 or designated areas;
 - 67 {(h)} (ii) camps on [sovereign land] state lands for longer than 15 consecutive days at the same location or within one mile of the same location;
 - 69 {(i)} camps on [sovereign land] state lands for 15 consecutive days, and then returns to
 70 camp at the same location before 15 consecutive days have elapsed after the day on which the
 71 person left that location;
 - 72 {(j)} leaves an anchored or beached vessel unattended for longer than 48 hours on sovereign land or navigable lakes or rivers;
 - 74 {(k)} anchors or beaches a vessel for longer than 72 hours at the same location, on sovereign land or navigable lakes or rivers, and then fails to move the vessel at least two miles from that location; or
 - 77 {-(h)} __(m) parks or operates motor vehicles on the beds of navigable lakes and rivers except in 78 those areas:
