

4th Sub. H.B. 140
SOVEREIGN LANDS AROUND BEAR LAKE

Senator **Margaret Dayton** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 3, Lines 65 through 78:*

(g) starts a campfire or camps on the bed of a navigable lake or river except in a posted and designated area:

- 65 ~~{(g)}~~ (h) camps on [~~the beds of navigable lakes or rivers~~] state lands, except in posted [~~and~~
- 66 ~~or~~ designated areas;
- 67 ~~{(h)}~~ (i) camps on [~~sovereign land~~] state lands for longer than 15 consecutive days at the
- 68 same location or within one mile of the same location;
- 69 ~~{(i)}~~ (j) camps on [~~sovereign land~~] state lands for 15 consecutive days, and then returns to
- 70 camp at the same location before 15 consecutive days have elapsed after the day on which the
- 71 person left that location;
- 72 ~~{(j)}~~ (k) leaves an anchored or beached vessel unattended for longer than 48 hours on
- 73 sovereign land or navigable lakes or rivers;
- 74 ~~{(k)}~~ (l) anchors or beaches a vessel for longer than 72 hours at the same location, on
- 75 sovereign land or navigable lakes or rivers, and then fails to move the vessel at least two miles
- 76 from that location; or
- 77 ~~{(l)}~~ (m) parks or operates motor vehicles on the beds of navigable lakes and rivers except in
- 78 those areas;
