CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION COMPREHENSIVE STUDY

Representative **Rich Cunningham** proposes the following amendments:

1. Page 2, Line 51 through Page 3, Line 60:

- 51 executive director of the Governor's Office of Economic Development's designee;  
52 ~~{(f)}~~ **(f)** a member of the State Board of Education, chosen by the chair of the State Board of  
53 Education;  
54 ~~(g)~~ **(g)** a member of the State Board of Regents, chosen by the chair of the State Board of  
55 Regents;}  
56 ~~{(h)}~~ **(f)** one member of the governor's staff, appointed by the governor;  
57 ~~{(i)}~~ **(g)** five private sector members, representing business or industry that employs  
58 individuals who hold certificates issued by a CTE program, appointed by the governor;  
59 ~~{(j)}~~ **(h)** a member of the Senate, appointed by the president of the Senate; and  
60 ~~{(k)}~~ **(i)** a member of the House of Representatives, appointed by the speaker of the House

2. Page 3, Lines 62 through 71:

- 62 (2) (a) Except as provided in Subsection (2)(b), the governor shall appoint CTE Board  
63 members described in Subsection ~~{(1)(f)}~~ **(1)(g)** to four-year terms.  
64 (b) The governor shall adjust the initial terms of the members appointed under  
65 Subsection ~~{(1)(f)}~~ **(1)(g)** so that the governor appoints approximately half of the members every two  
66 years.  
67 (c) A member appointed by the governor under Subsection ~~{(1)(f)}~~ **(1)(g)** may not serve more  
68 than two full consecutive terms unless the governor determines that an additional term or terms  
69 is in the state's best interest.  
70 (d) If a vacancy occurs in the membership appointed by the governor under Subsection  
71 ~~{(1)(f)}~~ **(1)(g)** for any reason, the governor shall appoint a replacement for the unexpired term.

3. Page 5, Lines 121 through 125:

- 121 use data collected by the Office of the Legislative Auditor General to complete the study.  
122 ~~{(3)}~~ **(3)(a)** The State Board of Education, State Board of Regents, and Utah College of  
123 Applied Technology shall:  
124 ~~{(a)}~~ **(i)** provide data that the department requests for the study; and  
125 ~~{(b)}~~ **(ii)** coordinate with the department to conduct the study.  
**(3)(b) Notwithstanding the requirements in Subsection (3)(a), the board shall have discretion to**  
**gather and report information as part of the comprehensive study of CTE that is readily accessible**

through current financial and data systems.
