Representative **James A. Dunnigan** proposes the following amendments:

- 1. Page 5, Lines 143 through 145:
 - 143 (4) A vice chair may perform the duties of a chair:
 - 144 (a) as requested by the chair; or
 - (b) in the absence of the chair.
 - (5) The chair, or the vice chair as authorized under Subsection (4), may designate a member of the committee to conduct a standing committee meeting when neither the chair nor the vice chair are able to attend a meeting.
 - (6) A committee member designated under Subsection (5) may conduct a committee meeting but may not perform the duties of a chair described in HR3-2-302 and HR3-2-303.
- 2. Page 8, Lines 215 through 220:
 - 215 (3) During the presentation phase of a standing committee meeting, the chair shall:
 - 216 <u>(a) permit the chief</u> <u>House</u>} <u>sponsor or</u> { <u>chief Senate sponsor</u>} <u>the legislator designated</u> <u>by the chief sponsor to be the floor sponsor in the opposite house</u> <u>to present the</u> <u>chief</u> <u>sponsor's</u>
 - 217 <u>legislation; and</u>
 - (b) except as provided in Subsection (4), and at the election of a legislative sponsor,
 - 219 permit persons who have expertise on the legislation to assist with the presentation as provided
 - 220 in HR3-2-304.
- 3. Page 14, Lines 403 through 411:
 - 403 (1) A standing committee may recommend that legislation in its possession be placed 404 on the consent calendar if:
 - 405 (a) the committee approves a motion, by a unanimous vote, that the legislation be read 406 a second time and placed on the third reading calendar;
 - (b) immediately subsequent to that action, the chief sponsor requests that the
 - 408 <u>legislation be placed on the consent calendar;</u> { and }
 - 409 (c) in a separate motion and vote, the committee unanimously approves the sponsor's
 - 410 request to place the legislation on the consent calendar instead of the second or third reading
 - 411 <u>calendar</u> { <u>and</u>
 - (d) the legislation does not have a fiscal note of \$10,000 or more.
