LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill amends the Election Code in relation to public disclosure of candidate information.

Highlighted Provisions:

This bill:

- requires the clerk of a county or a municipality to post the name and other information of a candidate who files a declaration of candidacy.

ENACTS:

20A-9-203.5, Utah Code Annotated 1953

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **20A-9-203.5** is enacted to read:

20A-9-203.5. Requirement to post candidate information on website.

The clerk of a county or a municipality shall, within three days after the day on which the clerk accepts a declaration of candidacy, post the following information on the website of
