Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **63G-2-107** is amended to read:

63G-2-107. Disclosure of records subject to federal law.



26 (1) Notwithstanding [~~the provisions of Subsections 63G-2-201(6)(a) and (b)~~
27 Subsection 63G-2-201(6)], this chapter does not apply to a record containing protected health
28 information as defined in 45 C.F.R., Part 164, Standards for Privacy of Individually Identifiable

33 (2) The disclosure of an education record as defined in the Family Educational Rights
34 and Privacy Act, 34 C.F.R. Part 99, that is controlled or maintained by a governmental entity
35 shall be governed by the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act, 34 C.F.R. Part 99.
