LONG TITLE

This bill amends provisions regarding implementing federal education programs.

REPEALS AND REENACTS:

53A-1-903, as last amended by Laws of Utah 2011, Chapter 342

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **53A-1-903** is repealed and reenacted to read:

53A-1-903. Federal programs -- School official duties.



26 (1) As used in this section, "prohibited federal program" means a program of the
27 federal government that conflicts with a state goal, objective, program need, or accountability
28 system.

29 (2) A school official may not apply for funds made available through a prohibited
30 federal program.

31 (3) Beginning with the 2019-20 school year, a school official may not receive or
32 administer funds made available through a prohibited federal program.

33 (4) A school official shall, to the extent allowed by law, reallocate any state resources
34 that are diverted to implement a prohibited federal program to meet state goals, objectives, and
35 program needs.
