## NOTICE OF BILL RETURNED TO RULES COMMITTEE

March 8, 2016

## Mr. Speaker:

The Education Committee has returned **H.B. 71**, WEIGHTED PUPIL UNIT CALCULATION EQUALIZATION AMENDMENTS, by Representative B. R. Cutler, to the Rules Committee without recommendation with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 3, Lines 71 through 80:
  - 71 (3) (a) Except as provided in Subsections (3)(b) and (3)(c), a charter school shall
  - receive state funds, as applicable, on the same basis as a school district receives funds.
  - 73 (b) (i) [For the 2015-16 school year, the] The number of weighted pupil units assigned to
  - a charter school for the kindergarten and grades 1 through 12 programs of the Basic School
  - 75 Program shall be:
  - 76 {-(i)-} (A) (based on the higher of: (A) October 1 enrollment in the current school year; or (B)
  - 77 <u>except as provided in Subsection (3)(b)(ii)</u>, average daily membership in the prior school year plus growth as determined under Section
  - 78 53A-17a-106; and
  - 79  $\{\frac{\text{(ii)}}{\text{(B)}}\}$  weighted as provided in Subsection (3)(c).

(ii) The number of weighted pupil units assigned to a charter school as described in Subsection (3)(b)(i) may be based on October 1 enrollment of the current school year if:

(A) the charter school's charter agreement states that the charter school's student population is composed of no less than 75% of students with special needs who have an individualized education program developed in accordance with the Individuals with Disabilities Education Improvement Act of 2004; and

(B) the governing board of the charter school described in Subsection
(3)(b)(ii)(A) requests that the weighted pupil units be based on October 1 enrollment and the State Board of Education approves the request.

80 (c) In distributing funds under Chapter 17a, Minimum School Program Act, to charter
