Representative **Val L. Peterson** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 6, Lines 154 through 176:*

- 154 53A-15-1705. Concurrent enrollment ~~{application}~~ participation form -- ~~{Student~~

157 (1) The State Board of Regents shall create a higher education concurrent enrollment
158 ~~{application}~~ participation form that includes ~~{an acknowledgment form and}~~ a parental
159 permission form.
160 ~~{(2) An institution of higher education shall use the application described in Subsection~~
161 ~~(1) for eligible students to participate in concurrent enrollment.}~~
162 ~~{(3)}~~ (2) Before allowing an eligible student to participate in concurrent enrollment, an LEA
163 and an institution of higher education shall ensure that the eligible student has, for the current
164 school year:
165 (a) submitted the ~~{application}~~ participation form described in Subsection (1);
166 (b) signed an acknowledgment of program participation requirements; and
167 (c) obtained parental permission as indicated by the signature of a student's parent or
168 legal guardian on the parental permission form.
169 Section 6. Section **53A-15-1706** is enacted to read:
170 53A-15-1706. Tuition and fees.
171 (1) Except as provided in this section, the State Board of Regents or an institution of
172 higher education may not charge tuition or fees for a concurrent enrollment course.
173 (2) (a) The State Board of Regents may charge a one-time fee for a student to ~~{apply to}~~
174 participate in the concurrent enrollment program.
175 ~~{(3)}~~ (b) A student who pays a fee described in Subsection (2) (a) does not satisfy a
176 general
177 admission application fee requirement for a full-time or part-time student at an institution of
178 higher education.
179 (3) (a) An institution of higher education may charge a one-time admission application fee for
180 concurrent enrollment course credit offered by the institution of higher education.
181 (b) Payment of the fee described in Subsection (3)(a) satisfies the general admission application fee
182 requirement for a full-time or part-time student at an institution of higher education.
183 (4) (a) Except as provided in Subsection (4)(b), an institution of higher education may
