 - 110 with agriculture use, and not for human occupancy, <u>or a structure that is no more than 1,500 square feet</u> and used solely for the type of sales described in Subsection 59-12-104(20), is exempt from the permit requirements of
 - 111 the State Construction Code.
 - 112 (b) (i) Unless exempted by a provision other than Subsection (7)(a), a plumbing,
 - electrical, and mechanical permit may be required when that work is included in a structure
 - 114 described in Subsection (7)(a).

 - 121 Title 17, Chapter 27a, Part 6, Subdivisions, and less than two contiguous acres.
 - 122 {(8) A structure that is no more than [1,000] <u>1,500</u> square feet and is used solely for the
 - 123 type of sales described in Subsection 59-12-104(20) is exempt from the permit requirements
 - 124 described in:
 - 125 (a) Chapter 2, Adoption of State Construction Code;
 - 126 (b) Chapter 3, Statewide Amendments Incorporated as Part of State Construction
 - 127 Code; and
 - 128 (c) Chapter 4, Local Amendments Incorporated as Part of State Construction Code. }
