Section 43. Section 26-58-207 is enacted to read:

26-58-207. Institutional review board -- Approved study of cannabidiol.

- (1) As used in this section:
- (a) "Institutional review board" or "IRB" means an institutional review board that is approved for human subject research by the United States Department of Health and Human Services.
 - (b) "Approved study" means a medical research study:
 - (i) the purpose of which is investigating the medical benefits of cannabidiol; and
 - (ii) that is approved by an IRB.
- (2) A person conducting an approved study, may, for the purposes of the study:
 - (a) purchase cannabis from a licensed cannabidiol cultivation facility in the state;
 - (b) purchase cannabidiol from a licensed cannabidiol dispensary in the state; and
- (c) <u>administer a product containing cannabis or cannabidiol to an individual in accordance</u> with the approved study.
- (3) A person conducting an approved study may import cannabis or cannabidiol from another state if:
 - (a) the importation complies with federal law; and
 - (b) the person uses the cannabis or cannabidiol in accordance with the approved study.
- (4) A person conducting an approved study may distribute cannabis or cannabidiol that the person obtained from a licensed cannabidiol cultivation facility in the state or licensed cannabidiol dispensary

in the state if:

- (a) the distribution complies with federal law; and
- (b) the distribution is for the purposes of, and in accordance with, the approved study.
- (5) The department shall issue an authorization to a person conducting an approved study to allow the person to purchase cannabis from a licensed cannabidiol cultivation facility in the state or cannabidiol from a licensed cannabidiol dispensary in the state
