RESCUE MEDICATION IN SCHOOLS

Representative **Gage Froerer** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 2, Lines 33 through 41:*

33 (1) As used in this section:

= **(a) "Prescribing health care professional" means:**

(i) a physician and surgeon licensed under Title 58, Chapter 67, Utah Medical Practice Act;

(ii) an osteopathic physician and surgeon licensed under Title 58, Chapter 68, Utah Osteopathic Medical Practice Act;

(iii) an advanced practice registered nurse licensed under Title 58, Chapter 31b, Nurse Practice Act; or

(iv) a physician assistant licensed under Title 58, Chapter 70a, Physician Assistant Act.

34 ~~{(a)}~~ **(b)** "Section 504 accommodation plan" means a plan developed pursuant to Section
35 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended, to provide appropriate accommodations to
36 an individual with a disability to ensure access to major life activities.

37 ~~{(b)}~~ **(c)** "Seizure rescue authorization" means a student's Section 504 accommodation plan

53 ~~{(c)}~~ **(d)** (i) "Seizure rescue medication" means a medication, prescribed by a
~~{licensed}~~ **prescribing** health
54 care professional, to be administered as described in a student's seizure rescue authorization,
55 while the student experiences seizure activity.

56 (ii) A seizure rescue medication does not include a medication administered
57 intravenously ~~{-}~~ **or intramuscularly.**

59 (i) is an employee of a public school where at least one student has a seizure rescue
60 authorization;
