	(1) As used in this section:
	(a) "Officer" means each:
	(i) county treasurer, county auditor, county assessor, county clerk, clerk of the district

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30	court, city treasurer, city clerk, justice court judge; and
31	(ii) other officer of a political subdivision.
32	(b) "Political subdivision" means a county, city, town, school district, local district, and
