29	(1) As used in this section, "sunscreen" means a compound topically applied to prevent
30	sunburn.
31	(2) A public school shall permit a student, without a parent or physician's
32	authorization, to possess or self-apply sunscreen that is:
33	(a) approved by the Food and Drug Administration; and
34	(b) not in an aerosol container.
35	(3) If a student is unable to self-apply sunscreen, a volunteer school employee may
36	apply the sunscreen on the student if the student's parent or legal guardian provides written
37	consent for the assistance.
38	(4) A volunteer school employee who applies sunscreen on a student in compliance
39	with Subsection (3) and the volunteer school employee's employer are not liable for:
40	(a) an adverse reaction suffered by the student as a result of having the sunscreen
