	WHEREAS, block grants offered by the federal government often include
main	tenance-of-effort provisions specifying required state spending levels necessary to receive

28	WHEREAS, if a state does not meet its maintenance-of-effort requirements in any
29	fiscal year, the federal government will often reduce dollar-for-dollar the state's federal block
30	grant in the following year;
31	WHEREAS, maintenance-of-effort requirements can be several times larger than the
32	amount of the federal block grant;
33	WHEREAS, large maintenance-of-effort requirements can severely limit state
34	legislative budget flexibility, especially during downturns;
35	WHEREAS, in fiscal year 2015, Utah received a \$3.2 million Mental Health Block
36	Grant that required a maintenance-of-effort obligation of \$29.3 million;
37	WHEREAS, in fiscal year 2015, Utah received a \$5 million Baby Watch Early
38	Intervention Grant that required a maintenance-of-effort obligation of \$12 million;
39	WHEREAS, in fiscal year 2015, Utah received a \$16.5 million Substance Abuse
40	Prevention and Treatment Block Grant that required a maintenance-of-effort obligation of
41	\$19.2 million; and
42	WHEREAS, the state of Utah obligates hundreds of millions of dollars in
43	maintenance-of-effort requirements:
44	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of the state of Utah
45	requests that Utah's congressional delegation submit federal legislation amending federal block
46	grant maintenance-of-effort requirements by adding the following language to each
47	maintenance-of-effort statutory requirement: "In nowise shall the state amount obligated as a
48	maintenance-of-effort calculation exceed the amount of federal funding provided through the
