LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill amends the Physician Assistant Act.

Highlighted Provisions:

This bill:

- ▶ amends the requirements of a delegation of services agreement;
- ▶ removes the requirement that a physician assistant obtain a co-signature ~~§~~ → on a chart

medical record of a prescription ← ~~§~~ from the supervising physician to prescribe certain controlled substances;

- ▶ amends requirements for licensure; and
- ▶ makes technical changes.
