**LONG TITLE**

**General Description:**

**34A-2-1004**, as enacted by Laws of Utah 2011, Chapter 328

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

Section 1. Section **34A-2-1004** is amended to read:

**34A-2-1004. Information required to obtain a waiver.**

To obtain or renew a waiver, a business entity shall submit to the commission:

- (1) a copy of two or more of the following:



28 (a) the business entity's federal or state income tax return that shows business income  
29 for the complete taxable year that immediately precedes the day on which the business entity  
30 submits the information;

31 (b) a valid business license;

32 (c) a license to engage in an occupation or profession, including a license under Title  
33 58, Occupations and Professions; or

34 (d) documentation of an active liability insurance policy that covers the business  
35 entity's activities; or

36 (2) a copy of one item listed in Subsection (1) and a copy of two or more of the  
37 following:

38 (a) proof of a bank account for the business entity;

39 (b) proof that for the business entity there is:

40 (i) a telephone number; and

41 (ii) a physical location; or

42 (c) an advertisement of services showing the business entity's name and contact  
43 information:

44 (i) in a newspaper of general circulation [~~or~~];

45 (ii) in a telephone directory [~~showing the business entity's: (i) name; and (ii) contact~~  
46 ~~information.];~~

47 (iii) on a website or social media; or

48 (iv) in a trade magazine.
