The Government Operations and Political Subdivisions Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 32**, ASSESSMENT AREA ACT AMENDMENTS, by Representative R. Curt Webb, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 7, Lines 186 through 190:*

186           (2) [~~The~~] Subject to Subsection (4) ~~{(d)}~~ , the assessment method a governing  
body uses  
187   to calculate an assessment may be according to frontage, area, taxable value, fair market  
value,  
188   lot, parcel, number of connections, equivalent residential unit, or any combination of  
these  
189   methods, or any other method as the governing body considers appropriate to comply  
with  
190   Subsections (1)(a) and (b).

2. *Page 8, Lines 218 through 221:*

218           (4) A local entity that levies an assessment under this chapter for economic  
promotion  
219   activities:  
220           (a) shall:  
221           (i) subject to Section 11-42-408, levy the assessment on each benefitted  
property; and
