Mr. Speaker,

The Education Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 92**, PHYSICAL RESTRAINT IN SCHOOLS, by Representative C. Spackman Moss, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 15 through 16:
  - 15 ▶ amends provisions related to a student who willfully defaces or otherwise {injures-} damages
  - school property; and
- 2. *Page 3, Lines 78 through 85:* 
  - 78 53A-11-806. Defacing or {-injuring-} damaging school property Student's liability Work
  - 79 program alternative.
  - 80 (1) [Any] A student who willfully defaces or otherwise { injures } damages any school property
  - 81 may be suspended or otherwise disciplined.
  - 82 (2) (a) [Any school district whose] If a school's property has been lost or willfully cut,
  - 83 defaced, or otherwise { injured } damaged [may], the school may withhold the issuance of an official written
  - grade [reports] report, diploma, [and transcripts] or transcript of the student responsible for the
  - damage or loss until the student or the student's parent or guardian has paid for the damages.
