Mr. Speaker,

The Education Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 92**, PHYSICAL RESTRAINT IN SCHOOLS, by Representative C. Spackman Moss, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 15 through 16:*

15 ▶ amends provisions related to a student who willfully defaces or otherwise {
 ~~injures~~} damages
16 school property; and

2. *Page 3, Lines 78 through 85:*

78 53A-11-806. Defacing or {~~injuring~~} damaging school property –
Student's liability – Work
79 program alternative.
80 (1) [~~Any~~] A student who willfully defaces or otherwise {~~injures~~} damages
 = any school property
81 may be suspended or otherwise disciplined.
82 (2) (a) [~~Any school district whose~~] If a school's property has been lost or willfully
cut,
83 defaced, or otherwise {~~injured~~} damaged [~~may~~], the school may withhold
the issuance of an official written
84 grade [~~reports~~] report, diploma, [~~and transcripts~~] or transcript of the student responsible
for the
85 damage or loss until the student or the student's parent or guardian has paid for the
damages.
