Mr. Speaker,

The Government Operations Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 207**, FEDERALISM AMENDMENTS, by Representative K. Ivory, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 11 through 13:*

11 This bill:

2. *Page 4, Lines 101 through 111:*
