Mr. Speaker,

The Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 261**, LOCAL EMERGENCY RESPONSE AMENDMENTS, by Representative D. V. Sagers, with the following amendments and recommends it be placed on the Consent Calendar.

1. *Page 2, Lines 38 through 41:*

38 (b) one representative from a private ambulance provider ~~{+}~~ ; ~~{+who:~~
39 ~~(i) may not serve more than two consecutive terms; and~~
40 ~~(ii) after the term under Subsection (1)(b)(i), shall be replaced by a member~~
41 ~~from a~~
~~different private ambulance provider; }~~

2. *Page 3, Lines 59 through 61:*

59 (b) Notwithstanding Subsection (2)(a), the governor ~~:~~
~~(i)~~ shall, at the time of appointment
60 or reappointment, adjust the length of terms to ensure that the terms of committee
members are
61 staggered so that approximately half of the committee is appointed every two years ~~;~~
~~(ii) may not reappoint a member for more than two consecutive terms; and~~
~~(iii) shall replace a member in Subsection (1)(b) with a member who is from a~~
~~different private provider than the member being replaced~~ .
