Mr. Speaker,

The Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice Committee reports a favorable recommendation on H.B. 261, LOCAL EMERGENCY RESPONSE AMENDMENTS, by Representative D. V. Sagers, with the following amendments and recommends it be placed on the Consent Calendar.

- 1. Page 2, Lines 38 through 41:
 - 38 (b) one representative from a private ambulance provider $\{---\}$; $\{---\}$; $\{---\}$
 - **39** (i) may not serve more than two consecutive terms; and
 - 40 (ii) after the term under Subsection (1)(b)(i), shall be replaced by a member
 - 41 different private ambulance provider;
- Page 3, Lines 59 through 61:
 - 59 (b) Notwithstanding Subsection (2)(a), the governor : (i) shall, at the time of appointment
 - or reappointment, adjust the length of terms to ensure that the terms of committee
 - members are
 - 61 staggered so that approximately half of the committee is appointed every two years
 - (ii) may not reappoint a member for more than two consecutive terms; and (iii) shall replace a member in Subsection (1)(b) with a member who is from a

different private provider than the member being replaced
