1. *Page 2, Line 26:*

3. *Page 3, Lines 59 through 60:*

59 (iii) shall :  
(A) initially replace ~~{a}~~ the member in Subsection (1)(b) with ~~{a member who is}~~ two members who are each from a different  
60 private provider than the member being replaced ; and  
(B) thereafter stagger each replacement of a member in Subsection (1)(b) so that one private provider does not hold both member positions under Subsection (1)(b).
