Mr. Speaker,

The Health and Human Services Committee recommends **H.B. 400**, COVERAGE PARITY FOR AMINO ACID-BASED FORMULA, by Representative E. H. Redd, be replaced and reports a favorable recommendation on **1st Sub. H.B. 400**, COVERAGE PARITY FOR AMINO ACID-BASED FORMULA with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 3, Lines 65 through 69:
 - 65 (2) Beginning { July 1, 2017 } plan year 2017-18 and ending plan year 2019-20 , the Public Employees' Benefit and Insurance Program shall
 - offer a 3-year pilot program within the state risk pool that provides coverage for the use of an
 - 67 <u>amino acid-based elemental formula, regardless of the delivery method of the formula, for</u> the
 - 68 diagnosis or treatment of an eosinophilic gastrointestinal disorder, food protein-induced
 - 69 enterocolitis syndrome, severe protein allergic condition, or short bowel syndrome.
- 2. *Page 3, Lines 83 through 85:*
 - (b) The Public Employees' Benefit and Insurance Program shall, on or before
 - 84 November 30, { 2020 } , report to the Social Services Appropriations

 Subcommittee regarding the
 - 85 costs and benefits of the program.
