The Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice Committee recommends **S.B. 12**, EXPUNGEMENT AMENDMENTS, by Senator D. W. Thatcher, be replaced and reports a favorable recommendation on **1st Sub. S.B. 12**, EXPUNGEMENT AMENDMENTS with the following amendments, and, due to unknown fiscal impact, recommends it be referred to the Rules Committee pending completion of a fiscal note.

1. *Page 13, Line 395 through Page 14, Line 400:*

395 ~~[Any person who willfully violates any prohibition in this chapter]~~ An employee or  
396 agent of an agency that is prohibited from disseminating information from expunged or  
397 pardoned records under Section {~~77-40-5.1~~} 77-27-5.1 or 77-40-109 who  
knowingly or intentionally  
398 discloses identifying information from the expunged or pardoned record that has been  
pardoned  
399 or expunged, unless allowed by law, is guilty of a class A misdemeanor [unless the  
prohibition  
400 specifically indicates a different penalty].
