The Business and Labor Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **S.B. 53**, LIS PENDENS AMENDMENTS, by Senator T. Weiler, with the following amendments and recommends it be placed on the Consent Calendar.

- 1. Page 1, Lines 8 through 9:
 - 8 General Description:
 - 9 This bill { <u>excludes</u> } <u>addresses</u> certain lien actions { <u>from</u> } <u>and</u> general lis pendens requirements.
- 2. Page 1, Lines 12 through 14:
 - 12 \rightarrow \{-\text{excludes actions involving construction and oil, gas, and mining liens}\} \\ \frac{\text{from the}}{\} \]
 - 13 general addresses lis pendens requirements due to notice requirements specified within those
 - 14 statutes .
- 3. Page 2, Lines 36 through 37:
 - 36 (3) This section does not apply { to } if a plaintiff satisfies the requirements of a notice of pendency of an action required by Section
 - 37 38-1a-701 or Section 38-10-106.
 - (4) If a complaint described in Subsection (1)(a) is amended after the notice is recorded, the plaintiff is not required to file an amended notice unless the property description has changed.
