Mr. Speaker,

The Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **S.B. 226**, PERMANENT CRIMINAL STALKING INJUNCTION AMENDMENTS, by Senator T. Weiler, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 13 through 20:*

- 13 This bill:
- 14 ▶ extends an application for a permanent criminal stalking injunction against a
person
- 15 in the following instances:
- 16 • a conviction of stalking;
 - 17 • a conviction of attempt to commit stalking;
 - 18 { ~~• a conviction of conspiracy to commit stalking;~~
 - 19 ~~• a conviction of solicitation to commit stalking;~~ } or
 - 20 • a plea to any of the above accepted by the court and held in abeyance.

2. *Page 4, Line 115 through Page 5, Line 123:*

- 115 (9) (a) The following serve as an application for a permanent criminal stalking
116 injunction limiting the contact between the defendant and the victim:
- 117 (i) a conviction for:
- 118 (A) stalking;
- 119 (B) attempt to commit stalking;
- 120 { ~~(C) conspiracy to commit stalking; or~~
- 121 ~~(D) solicitation to commit stalking; } or~~
