The Health and Human Services Committee recommends **S.B. 246**, PHARMACY PRACTICE ACT AMENDMENTS, by Senator E. J. Vickers, be replaced and reports a favorable recommendation on **1st Sub. S.B. 246**, PHARMACY PRACTICE ACT AMENDMENTS with the following amendments and that it be considered read for the second time and placed on the Consent Calendar.

1. *Page 7, Lines 182 through 188:*

182 (3) A pharmacist may not administer a drug listed under Subsection (2) unless the
183 pharmacist:
184 (a) completes the training described in Subsection (2);
185 (b) administers the drug at a clinic or community pharmacy, as those terms are
 defined
186 by the division, by administrative rule made in accordance with Title 63G, Chapter 3,
 Utah
187 Administrative Rulemaking Act; and
188 (c) is directed by the {~~practitioner~~} **physician, as that term is defined in**
 Section 58-67-102 or Section 58-68-102, who issues the prescription to administer the
 drug.
